

Student Organization Guidance for Transitioning Officers

Elections and Officer Transitions

Student Organization Elections:

- Current Student Organization Officers organize elections:
 - Announce election date to members and list who is eligible to run (members in their year of pharmacy school, etc.)
 - If there are multiple people running for a position, each candidate is encouraged to submit a short-written platform or draft of their speech to the organization leader. A date should be scheduled on or before the election where the candidates will give their short speech to the group.
 - Of note, if an individual runs for a position unopposed, they may assume their position on election day.
 - Organizations are encouraged to have a standard mechanism to cast votes, for example Google Form.
 - Current officers should conduct the vote count and announce results.
- As soon as election results are final, current officers must inform Student Program Administrator (Mrs. Suzanne Mannino) and their faculty advisor of election results, including names of new officers and positions.
- Advisors are encouraged to meet with new and outgoing student officers for a transition meeting to include:
 - Organization goals
 - o Major event planning for upcoming academic year
 - Discussion of budget responsibility of the student officers
 - Ensure updates made to SORC (Student Organization Resource Center). The President must report:
 - Advisor(s)
 - Names of elected officers/E-Board Members
 - Names and Number of student members (can be updated throughout the year)

School of Pharmacy and National Association Annual Reports

- Many Student Organizations have an affiliated national association that requires an Annual Report.
 When completing the report:
 - o Ensure it is reviewed by your Advisor
 - o Provide a final copy to Student Program Administrator (Mrs. Suzanne Mannino)
