## **Sound Scholarship**

- Overall preprofessional performance
- Performance in required science and math courses
- Consistency of performance
- Depth and breadth of courses





# **Community Involvement**

- Participation in activities that benefit the community
- Significant involvement in college clubs or groups





## Leadership

- Selection to positions of leadership by faculty or peers
- Positions held within an organization
- Service as a resident or teaching assistant





# **Communication Ability**

- Performance in speech course
- Well-written personal statement
- Extracurricular activities and work experience
- Interview
