



Pitt Pharmacy MS Scholarship

Pitt Pharmacy is offering \$10,000 scholarships to highly qualified and motivated students seeking a thesis MS degree in Pharmaceutical Sciences for fall enrollment.

To be considered for the Pitt Pharmacy MS Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a US citizen, non-citizen national, or permanent resident of the United States
- Submit a completed application to the University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy MS program in Pharmaceutical Sciences – all complete MS applications will be evaluated for eligibility; no additional scholarship application is needed.
- Have a record of distinguished academic achievement (e.g., grade point average, honors, or other designation)
- Demonstrate professionalism, excellent communication, and leadership skills

Additional consideration will be given to those who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Come from an educational, cultural, or geographic setting that is underrepresented in graduate studies within the health sciences in the United States or specifically at the University of Pittsburgh
- Demonstrate continuous commitment to fostering social, educational and economic diversity and supporting the underrepresented within academic, professional, or community spheres through their professional experiences, volunteer commitments, or leadership roles in student or community organizations
- Have faced financial hardship stemming from family economic circumstances
- Are first-generation college students or first-generation U.S. citizens

All applicants who meet these criteria will be given individualized consideration during the review process based on consideration of the application as a whole, and no one factor will be determinative.
